



FEDERAL & ONTARIO DISABILITY TAX CREDIT

(2017 Income Tax)

You are eligible for the disability only if a qualified medical practitioner certifies on form T2201 that you have a prolonged impairment and that the effects are such that any one of the following applies:

You are markedly restricted in any **one** of the following:

- Speaking
- Hearing
- Vision
- Walking
- Eating
- Dressing
- Elimination (bowel or bladder functions) or
- Performing the mental functions necessary for everyday life.

This is a tax credit (not refundable but a credit) of \$1627 for 2017. If the person applying has no taxable income, the credit can be transferred to another relative who provides support.
