

Free Tax Preparation Clinics

(March & April 2018)
(2017 Taxes)

Eligibility

The following are available for individuals whose 2016 income does not exceed \$30,000 for singles, \$40,000 for couples; including not more than \$1,000 interest income.

Clinics do not complete returns for tax situations involving any of the following:

- Self employed or have employment expenses
- Business or rental income and expenses
- Capital gains or losses
- Filed for bankruptcy
- Tax return for a person who is deceased

What to bring to tax clinics:

- all tax forms, last year's Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency, rent/property tax receipts, and medical receipts if over 3% of income

Note there is no indoor waiting space at Central Library prior to 9:00 am
